

Giving Tree

You may have noticed that the Giving Tree has made another appearance in the Sanctuary. One of our member families has had an extremely difficult time over the last five years with multiple illnesses, family crises, and employment issues. It sometimes felt as if they not only had their share of bad luck, but that they had gotten everyone else's as well. Consequently, their home mortgage is in jeopardy. In order to be eligible for refinancing, the family must pay \$1350 for each of three months. After prayerful consideration, the issue of helping the family

avoid foreclosure was brought to Session. It was agreed to help the family in two ways. PW was asked and agreed to make the February 1st payment. Secondly, we are reaching out to the congregation for donations of any amount toward the next two payments. Throughout this time of struggle, the family has remained faithful and supportive to our church. We would like to help them with our prayers and emotional support, but also with financial assistance. If you would like to contribute to this project, please take an envelope from the tree, and return it with your donation to the offering plate during Feb. and March. If you include your name and envelope #, your contribution will be listed on your yearly giving record. Checks may be written to WMPC.
